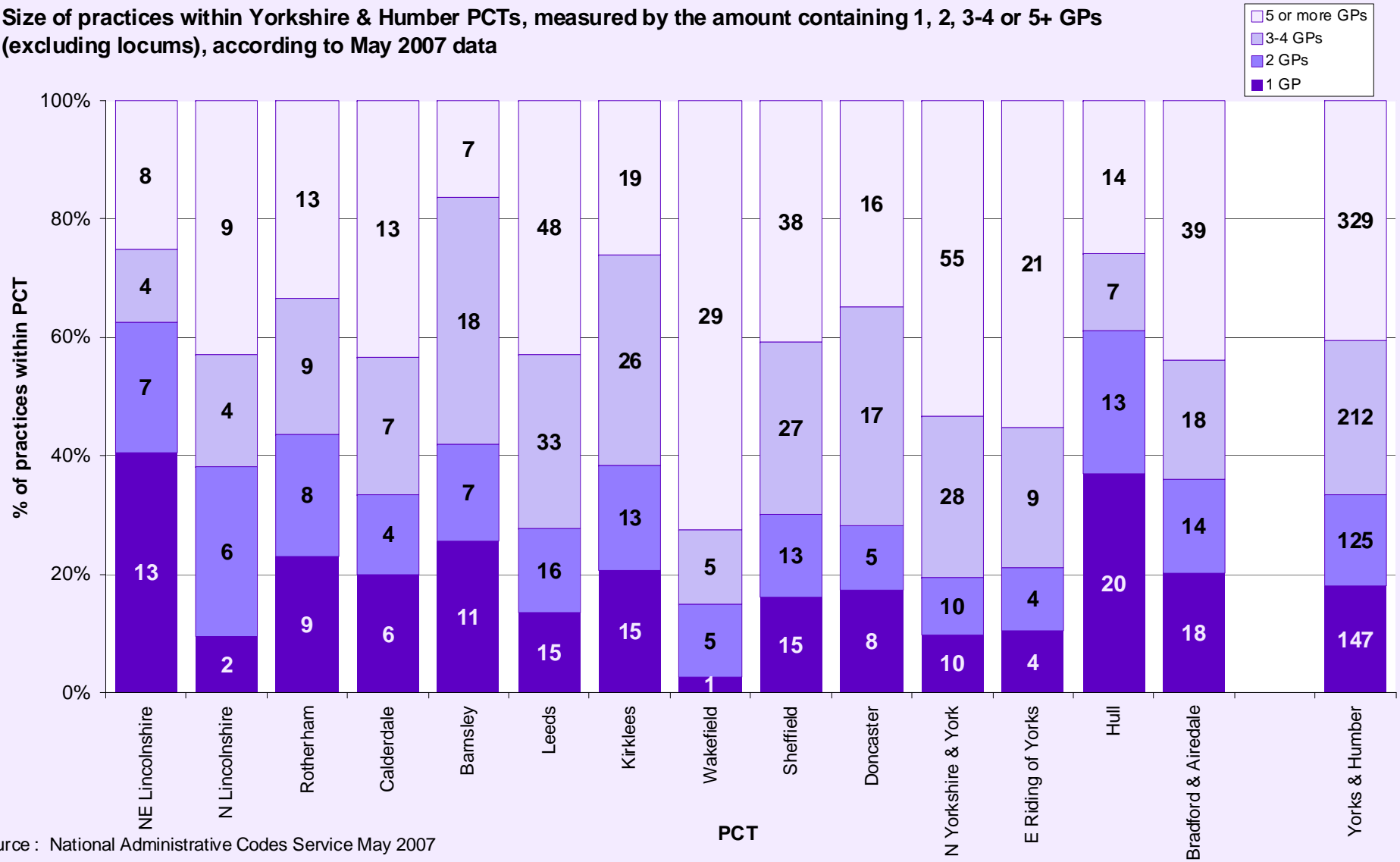

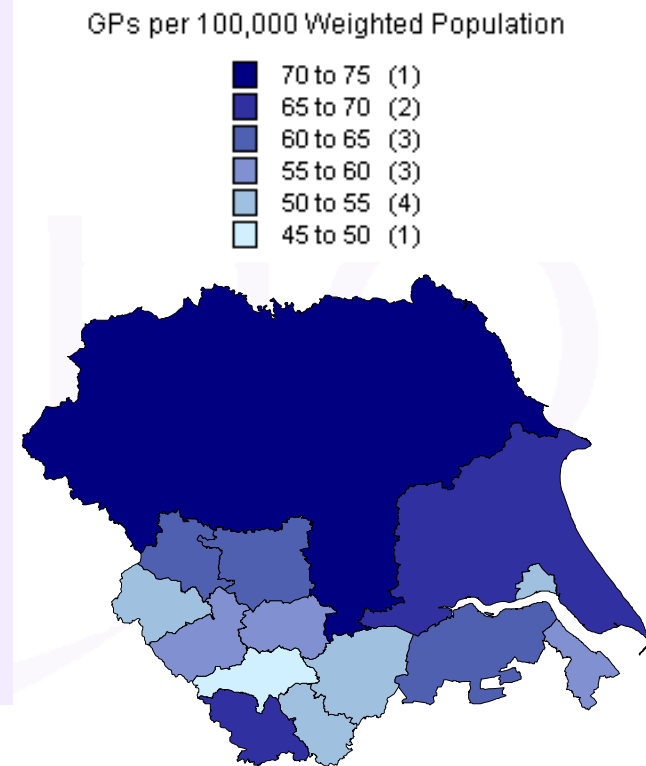
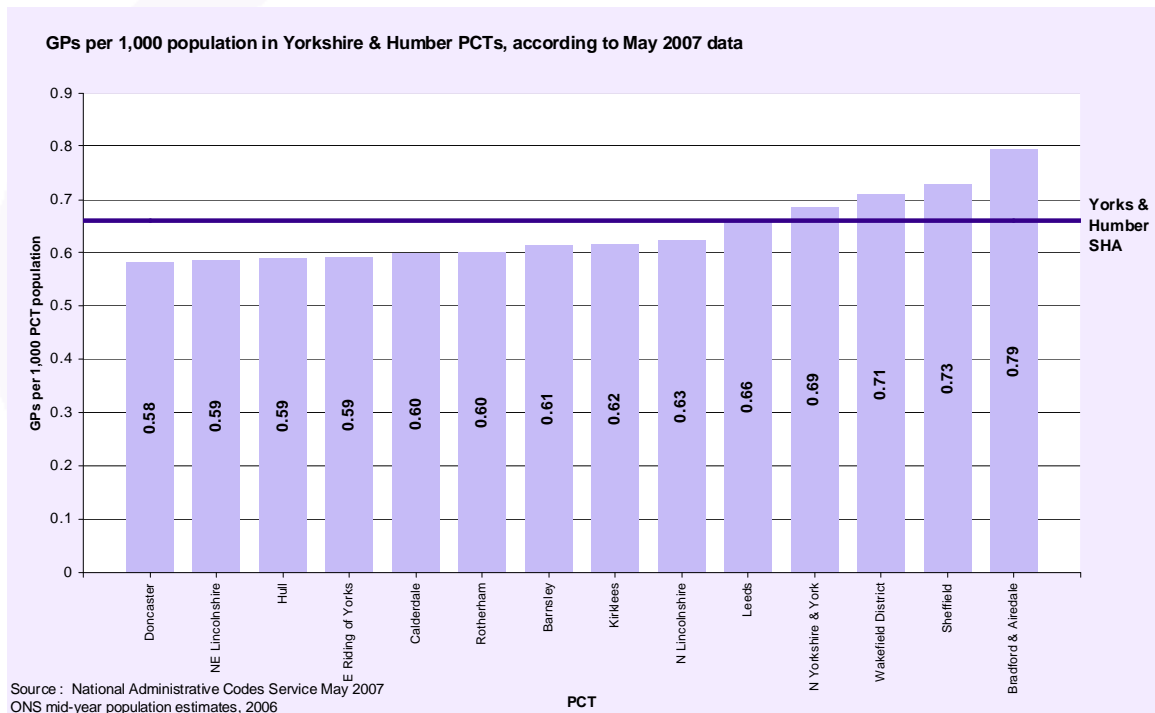

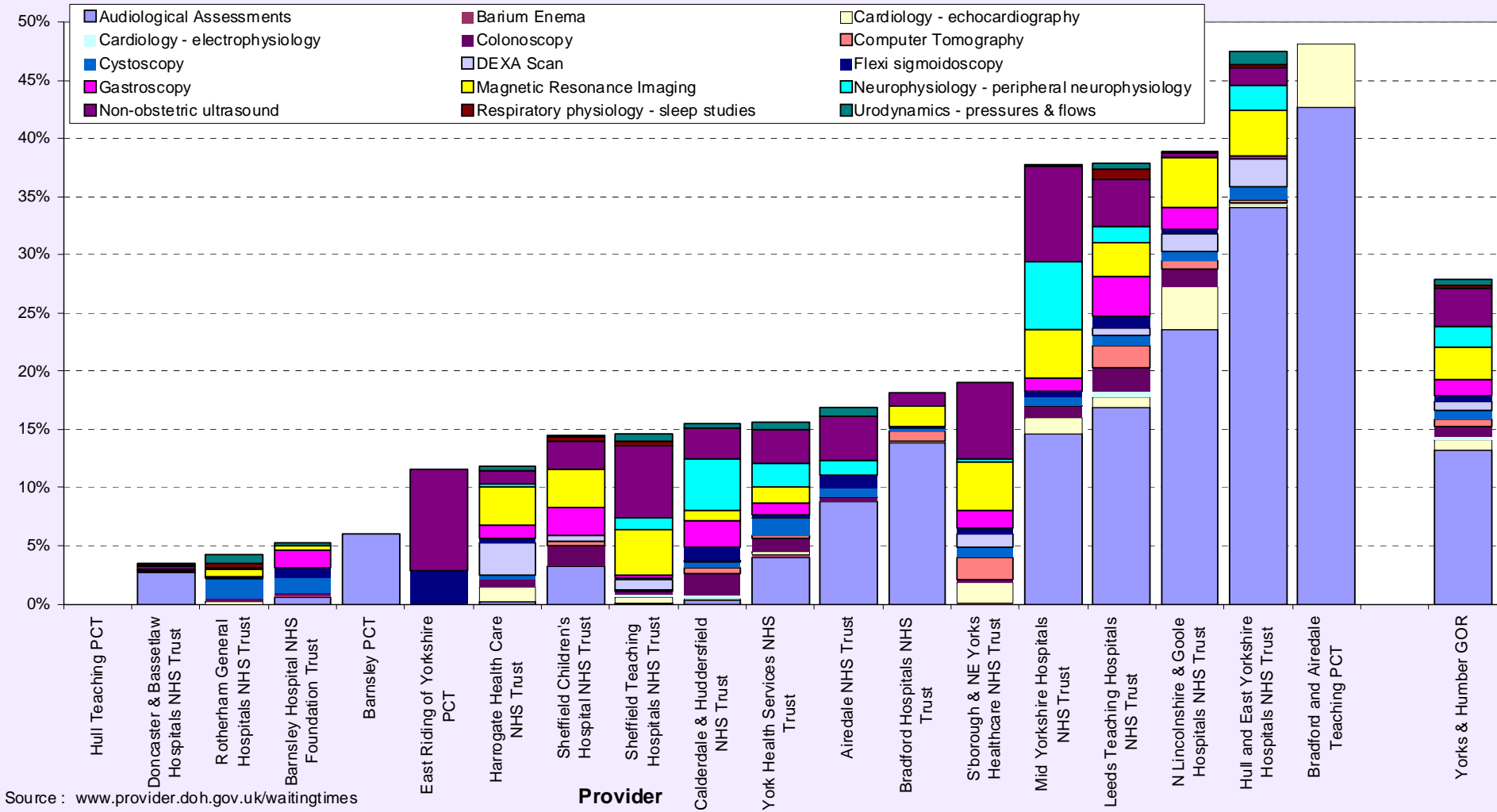

Percentage of patients waiting for diagnostic procedures at the end of July 2007 that have been waiting longer than 6 weeks, broken down by diagnostic procedure

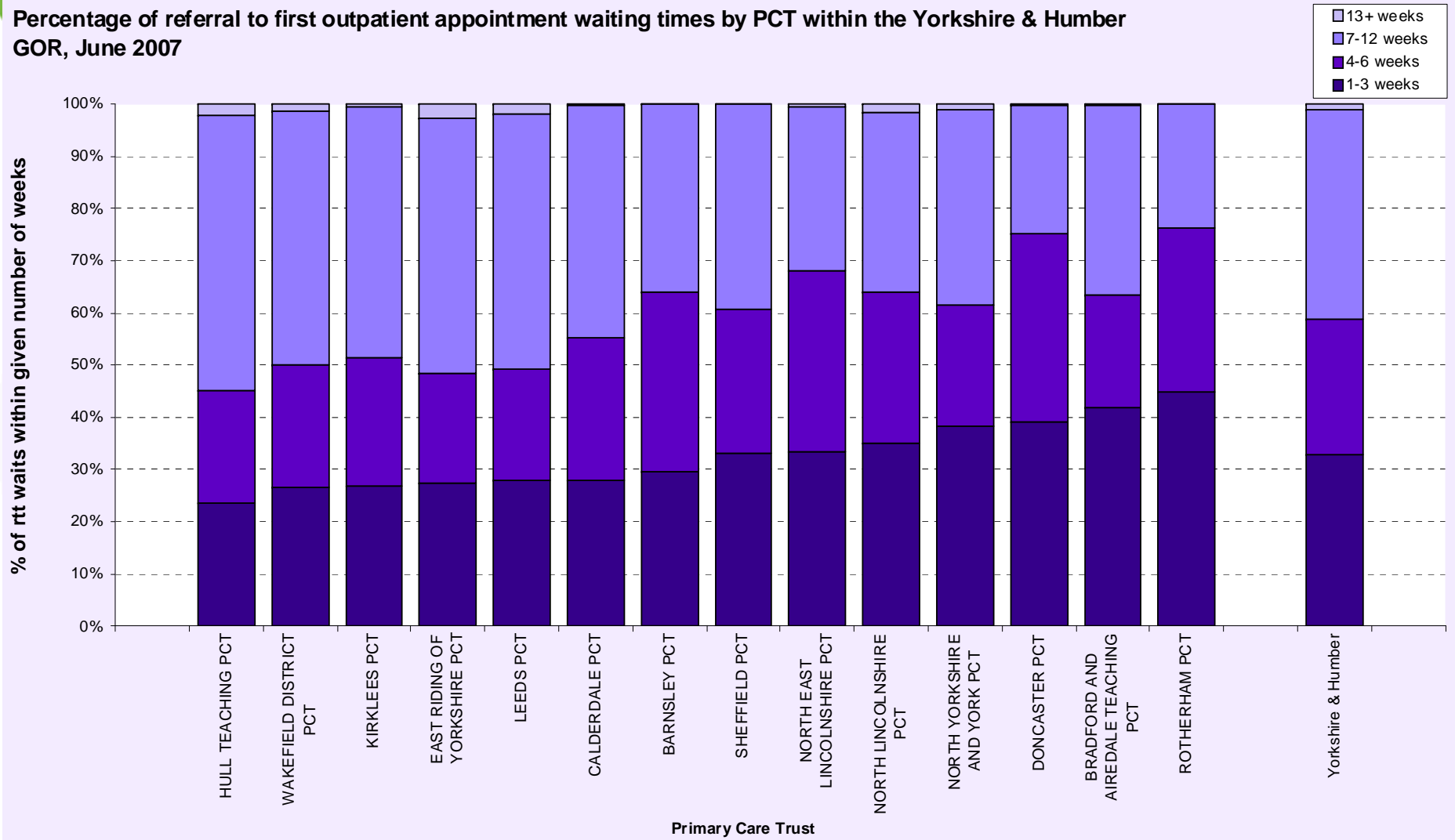

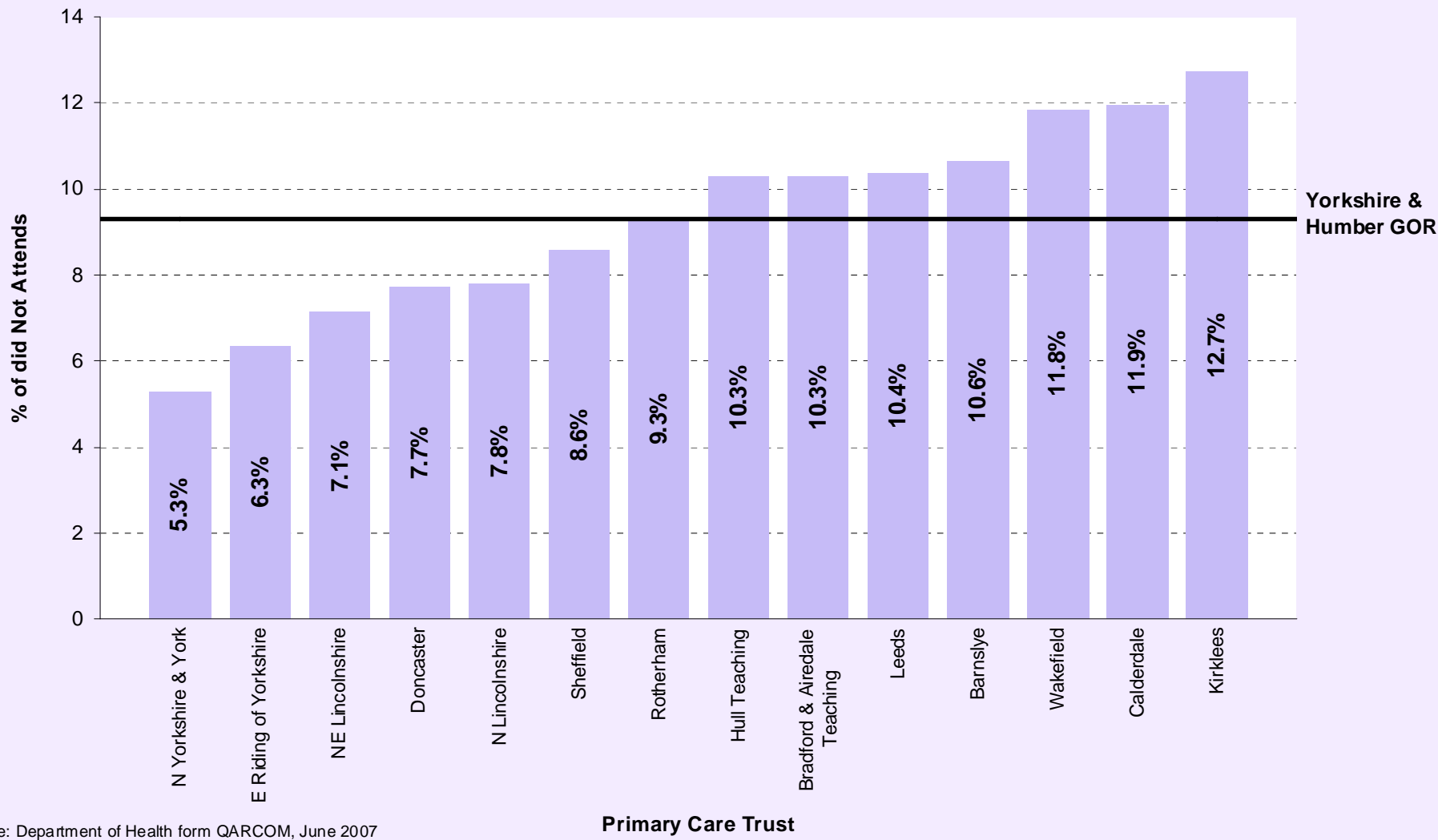

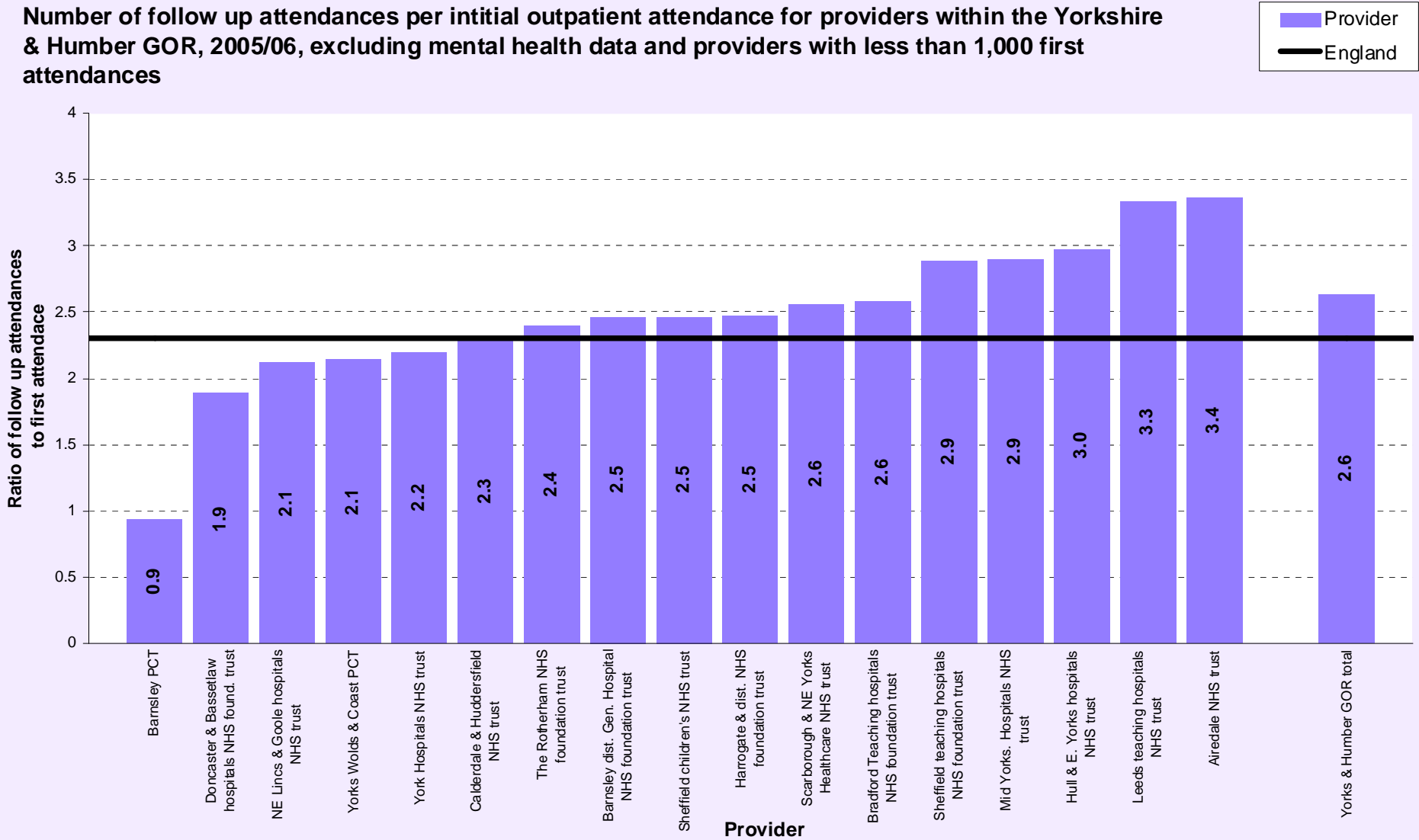
Did Not Attend rates for first Outpatient appointments, PCTs in the Yorkshire & Humber GOR, June 2007

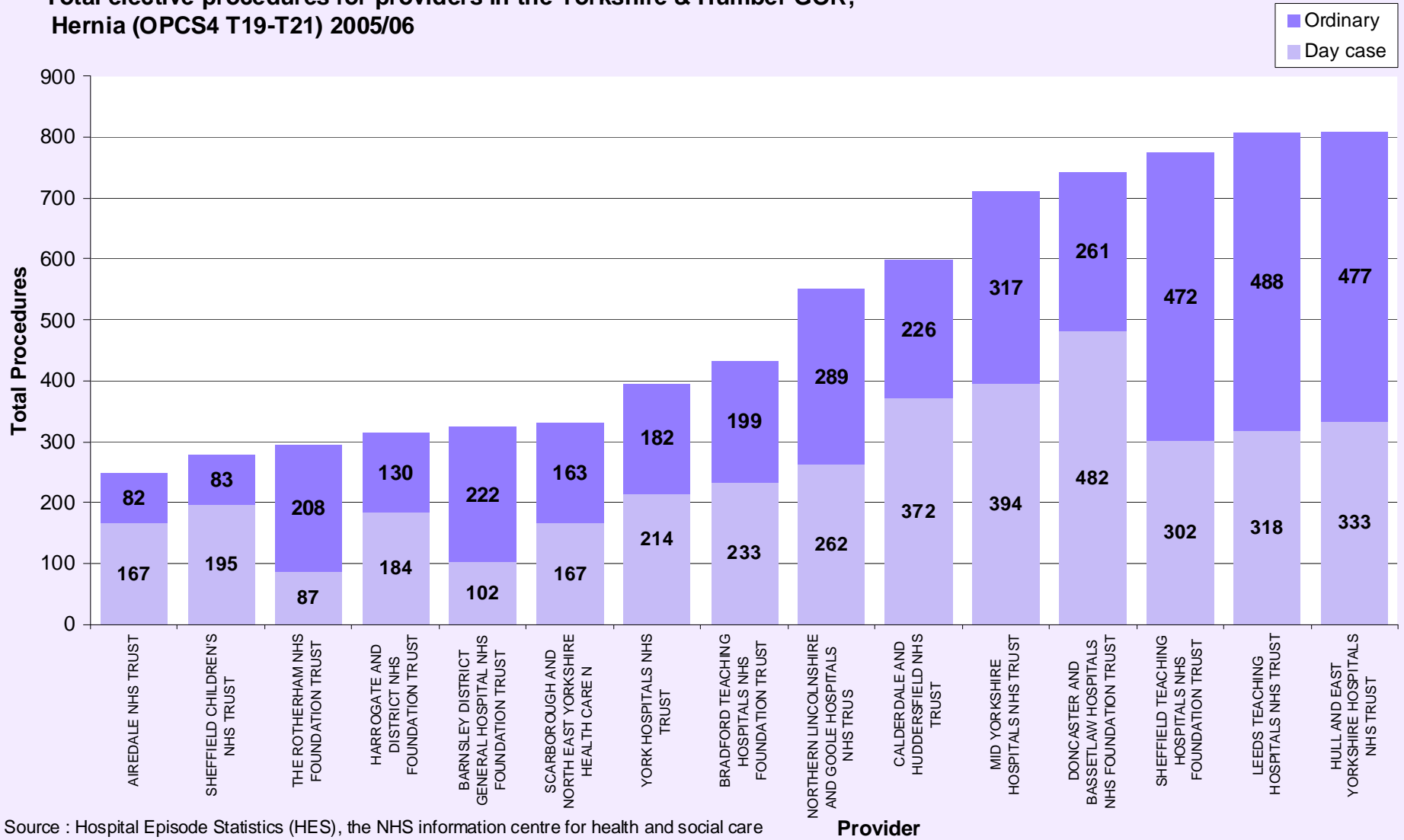

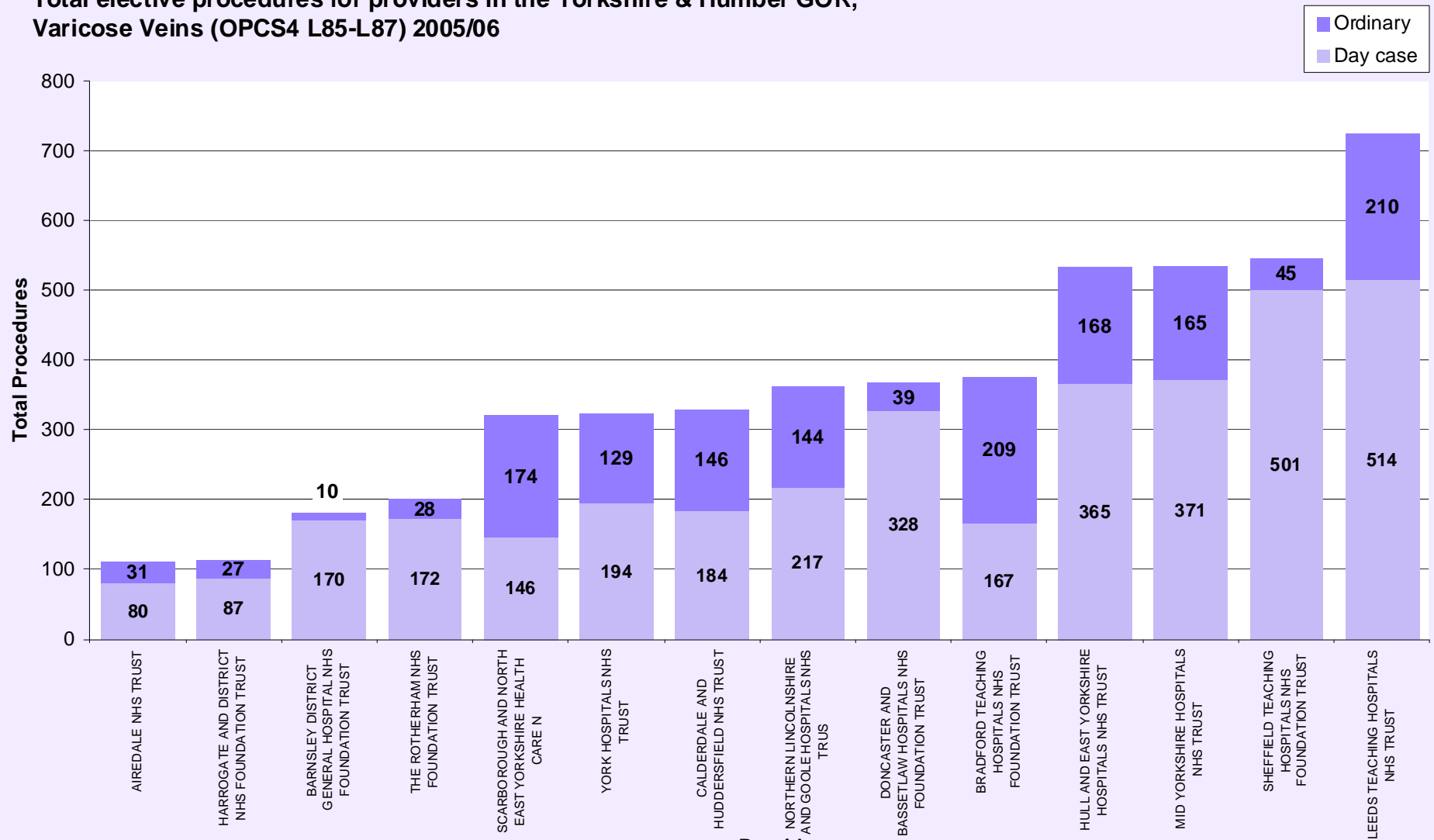


Total elective procedures for providers in the Yorkshire & Humber GOR, Hernia (OPCS4 T19-T21) 2005/06

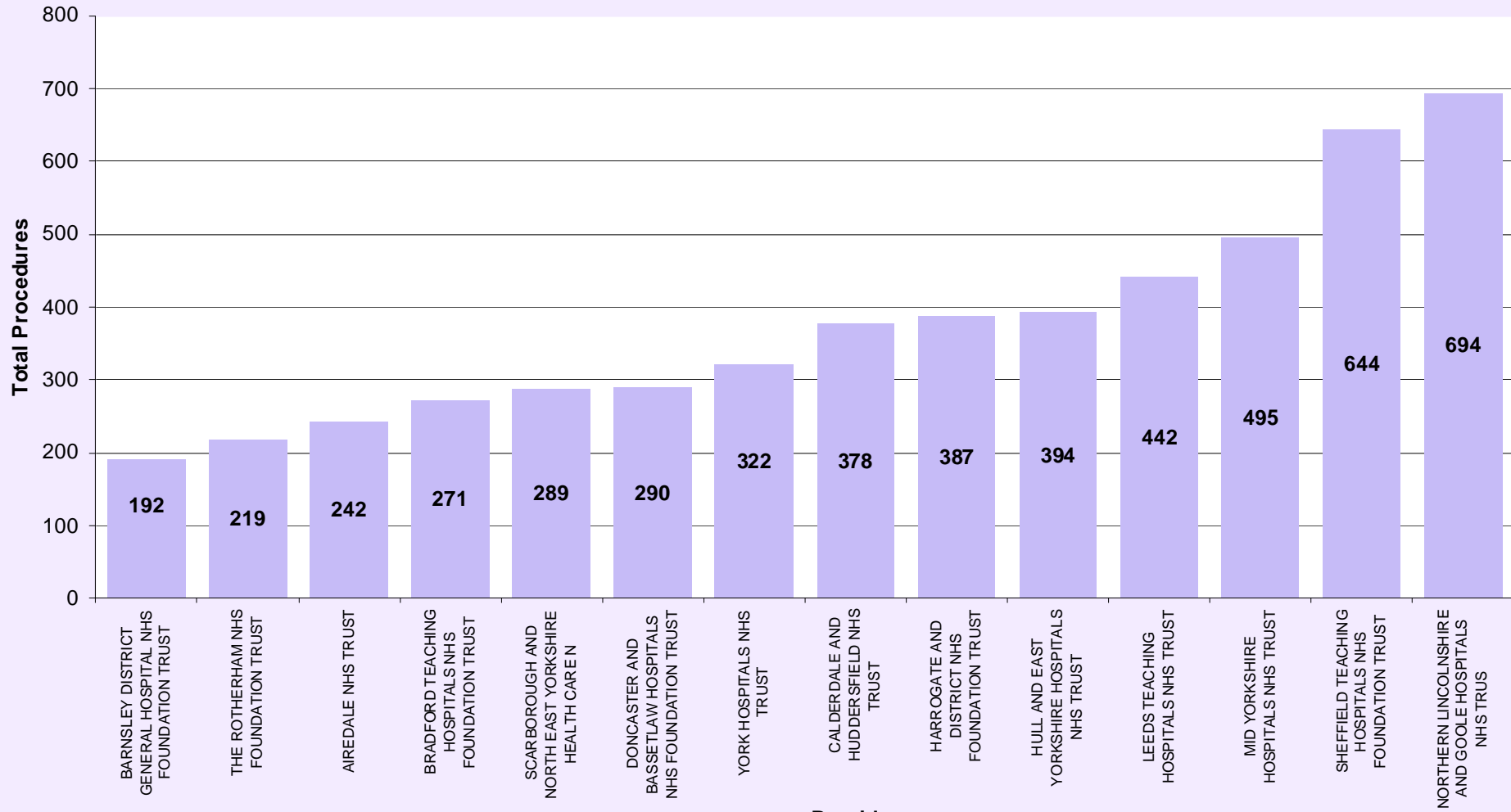
Total elective procedures for providers in the Yorkshire & Humber GOR, Varicose Veins (OPCS4 L85-L87) 2005/06

Hip replacements (OPCS4 W37-W39, W46-W48), 2005/06**



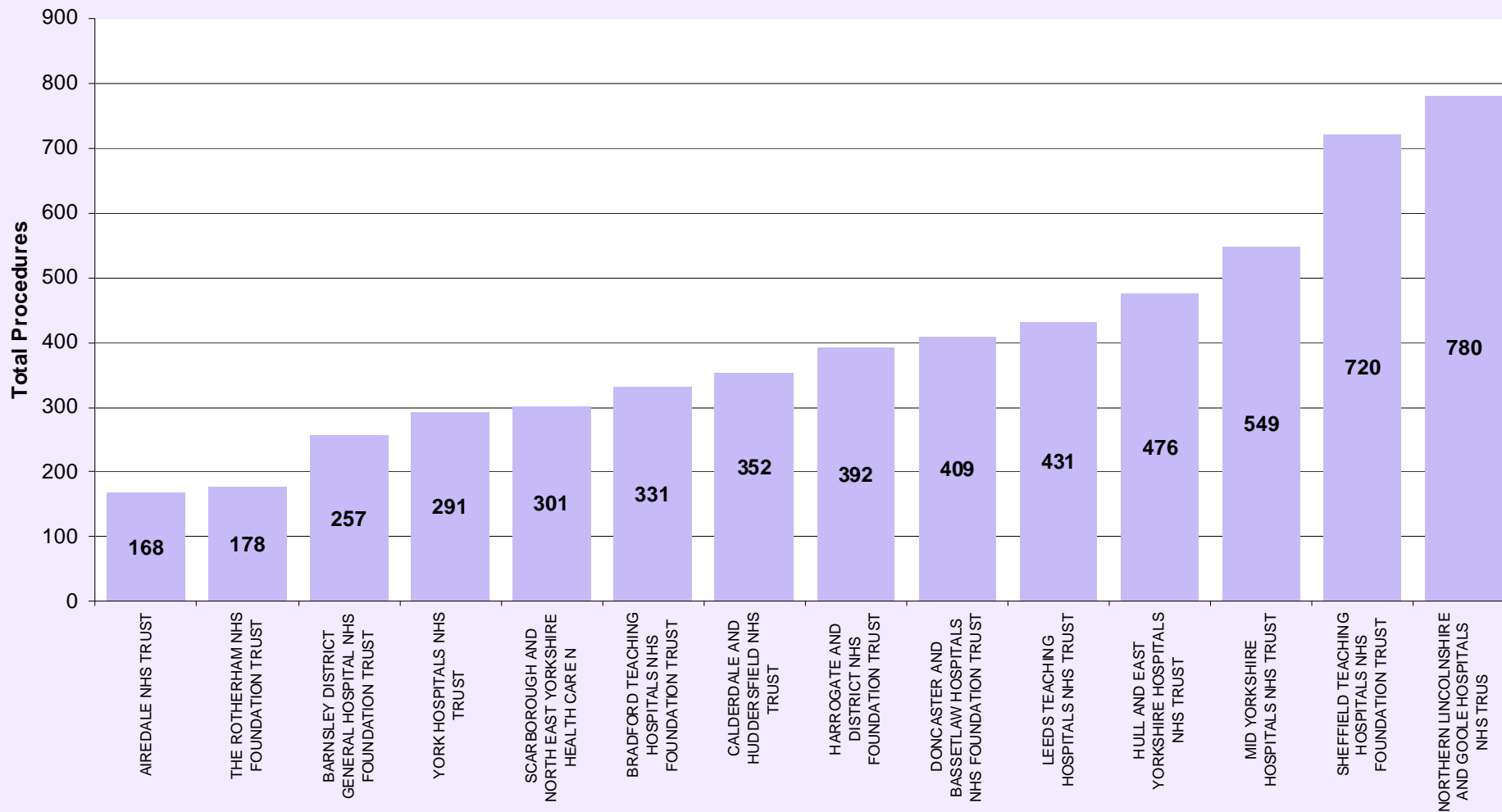

Knee replacements (OPCS4 W40-W42), 2005/06**



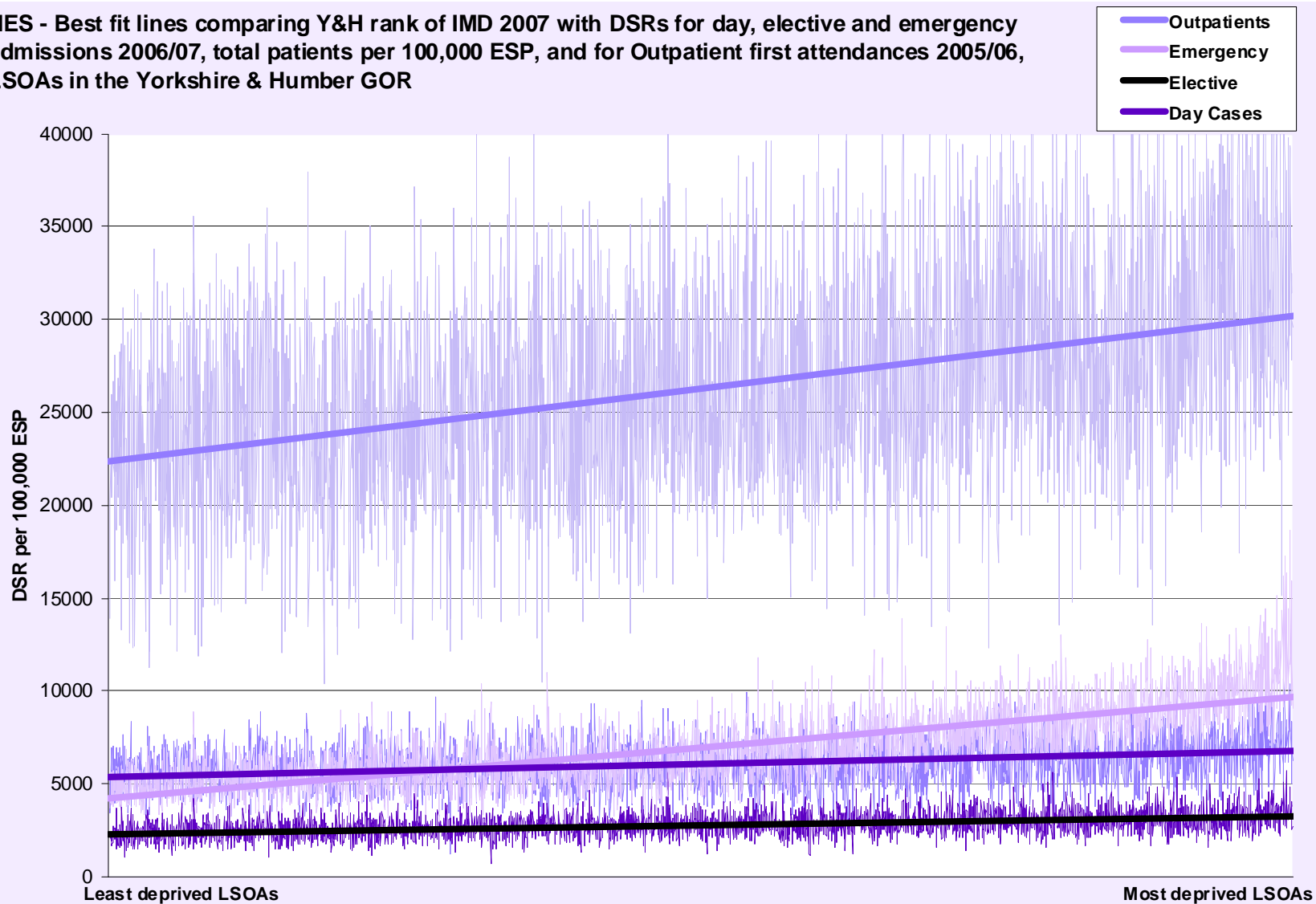
