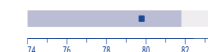

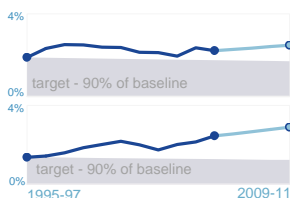
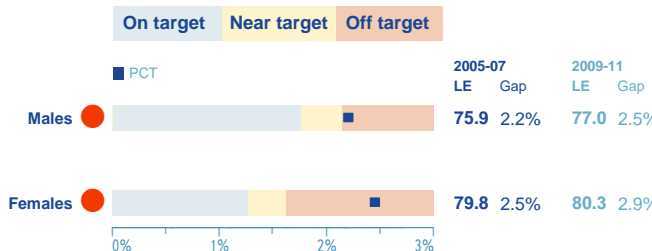
# Life expectancy at birth in Bradford 2005-07

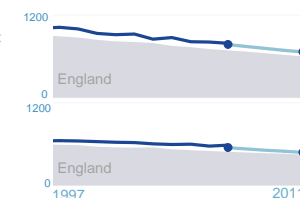
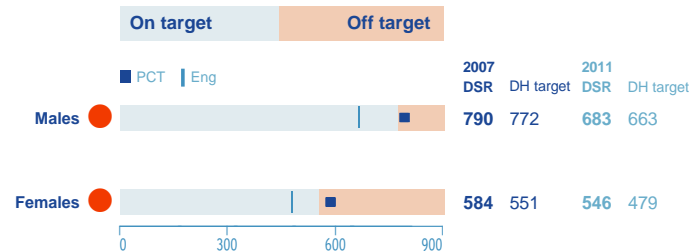
## Relative life expectancy gap between Bradford and England - 2005-07

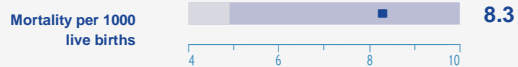
## All age all cause mortality 2007 - DSR per 100,000 people

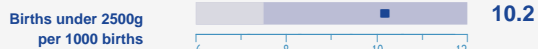

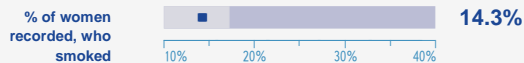

## Low birth weight births - 2007



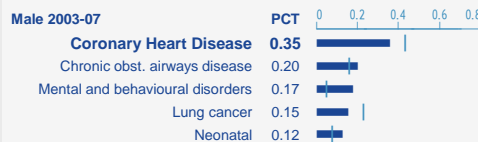
## Smoking at time of delivery - Q1 2009/10

(assuming district has the same mortality rate as England)

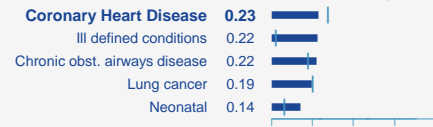

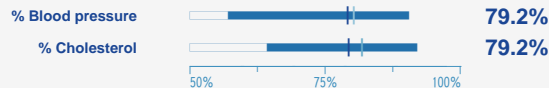

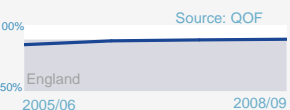
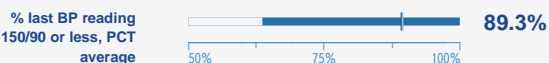
## Long term conditions within manageable limits - 2008/09

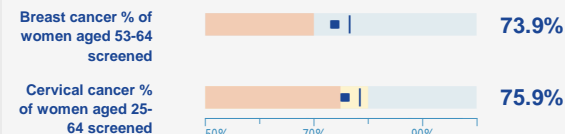


## Patients with CHD - 2008/09

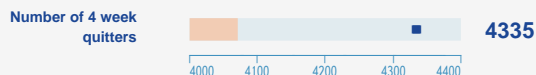
## Slope Index of Inequality for LE by Deprivation Deciles - 2003-07
